Don't let your cell phone or other distractions cause you to crash.

Each year, distracted driving kills more than 3,000 people. Distractions are a part of everyday life, but you can learn to identify and manage them. If you are driving, do not text or talk on a cell phone or engage in other distractions while you're behind the wheel. And if you are a passenger in someone else's car, make sure you are not causing the driver to be distracted. Remember this simple slogan: Eyes on the road. Hands on the wheel. Head in the game. **Sign and date this pledge. Ask your parent or guardian to sign it too. Post it in your home as a daily reminder of safe driving.**
